#### **Examples:**

-Give to Direct Relief Funds for immigrant families (particularly undocumented and mixed status families, as well as unaccompanied minors)

-Provide unrestricted funding to immigrant-serving organizations, particularly those led by POCs

#### **Examples:**

-Adopt and equity lens in funding practices, recognizing that many communities will require more resources to recover

-Make deeper investments in organizations with more stable, multi-year funding

-Consider the impacts of trauma and toxic stress had on communities and encourage meaningful, authentic collaboration

#### **Examples:**

-Fund movement-building organizing work that centers leadership of immigrants and refugees

-Develop strengths-based strategies that lean more heavily on how we can build upon what communities bring to the table rather than focusing primarily on needs and challenges

-Create opportunities for immigrants and refugees to build their leadership and capacity through participatory grantmaking

## Immigrant-focused Funding Opportunities in PA

#### **PA IS READY Immigrant Relief Fund**

Statewide fund to provide direct emergency assistance to people excluded from federal COVID-19 assistance programs due to their immigration status or the immigration status of a family member and are in need of immediate financial assistance.

### Community Fund for Immigrant Wellness

Serves diverse immigrant communities throughout Philadelphia by providing financial support and capacity building to organizations which promote wellness. Stewarded by a granting group of community-based, immigrant serving organizations and local philanthropic organizations who are deeply committed to shifting power dynamics between philanthropy and service organizations by utilizing a transparent shared decision making process.

#### **PA Immigrant Family Unity Project:**

A collaborative of nonprofit organizations in Pennsylvania formed in order to achieve universal representation for detained immigrants in removal proceedings in Pennsylvania.

### PA is Ready! Fund

An innovative, community-led network and participatory grantmaking fund rooted in and serving diverse immigrant and refugee communities across Pennsylvania. The overarching goal of the *PA is Ready!* network is to ensure that immigrant communities have the skills and resources necessary for building safe and welcoming communities that promote all resident's well-being.
