

#### **SURVEY RESPONSES:**


- All types of nonprofit causes & fields of interest
- 60% with operating budgets <\$1M; 90% with operating budgets <#5M
- 67% employ less than 10 FTE; typically engage substantial # of volunteers, mostly unable to provide hands on help during COVID




#### MATURE, EXPERIENCED NONPROFITS & STAFF, throughout Chester County

70% of staff & board respondents have been devoted to nonprofit field for over a decade; 35% over two decades




### Q1: How significantly has the COVID pandemic impacted your nonprofit?





### Q2: How is your nonprofit operating since COVID restrictions began in March 2020?











# Q7: What do you anticipate re: your nonprofit's EMPLOYEE compensation &/or benefits over the coming 12 months?




