# Purpose: COVID Response Dashboard

To support a more informed, coordinated, regional response among philanthropic funders, by providing information on:

**What** the needs are for philanthropic funding

**Where** that need is

**Who** is receiving aid

**How & When** major relief funds are responding

# Regional COVID Response Dashboard

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The scale of COVID-19's effects means that funders everywhere need better tools for understanding where their funds can do the most good. This dashboard is one of the first efforts we are aware of to collect grant award data across multiple funders and visualize them against indicators of community need. It reflects \$42,757,183 of grant awards from 13 **COVID-19 response funds** in Southeastern Pennsylvania and Southern New Jersey. By visualizing funding to date and where need remains high, this dashboard serves as a community asset to help all funders plan beyond the initial relief efforts.
