Opportunities for OST

- Both the current mayor's race and an upcoming strategic plan from the school district provide strong opportunities for OST
- Main issue for voters in the primary was crime
- Preview of the new <u>strategic plan</u> to be released includes a focus on youth safety, emotional, and physical health and efficient high quality operations including partnering with organizations

BOOST Bill

- Building Opportunity through Out of School Time (BOOST)
- A bill is being introduced in the PA Legislature to dedicate a line item of funding for OST programming across PA
- Current version would initially dedicate \$70 million dollars to be distributed to organizations and school districts through a competitive RFP
- Research for Action released a <u>PACER Brief</u> in support of the bill
- Over half of US states are currently funding OST
- All the states bordering PA except West Virginia currently directly fund OST
